Graduate students seeking funding in the department are encouraged to look for associateships outside of the department. If a graduate student finds an associateship outside of the department, AAEP will honor the year(s) they completed an associateship outside of the department up to 1 year for an MA student and up to 2 years for a PhD student. For example, if a PhD student completes 2 years of an associateship position outside of the department, they can still be eligible for 3 years of an associateship within AAEP, extending their total years of eligible funding from 3 to 5.

Appointments are issued on an academic year basis (autumn and spring semesters). Appointments may be assigned on a semester basis depending upon departmental needs. Appointments are evaluated annually and are not guaranteed from year to year. Reappointments are made depending upon availability of funds, satisfactory performance, and successful academic progress. Summer term appointments are arranged separately. There are no guarantees of appointment beyond that specified in the student's initial appointment document.

Applications for GTA appointments cannot be considered before admission to the graduate program. Therefore, to be considered for a GTA position, the program application and all supplemental materials must be completed by November 30th.
