Established in 2019, the *Barbara Strutin Schwartz and Stanley Schwartz Scholarship Fund for Arts Management* aims to support and recognize outstanding students in the Arts Management program in the Department of Arts Administration, Education & Policy at The Ohio State University. The scholarship is awarded to students who demonstrate exceptional merit and academic potential, fostering the next generation of leaders in arts management.

Eligibility and Selection Criteria:

- First preference shall be given to candidates seeking a career in community arts organizations.
- Applicants must be of **junior or senior standing** and should demonstrate a strong understanding of the **role of arts programming** and its impact on communities is required.
- A GPA of 3.0 or higher is expected.

The Undergraduate Studies Committee, in consultation with Arts Management faculty, will select the scholarship recipients.

Award Details:

- The scholarship will be applied directly to your **OSU Bursar's account** in the semester it is awarded.
- Applicants should be aware that current or future financial aid arrangements may be affected by receipt of this award.
- The scholarship amount is **\$ 3750.00**

Application:

To apply, you should submit:

- 1. Application Form (this document).
- 2. A two-page essay that addresses your personal passion for community arts programming (fine arts, dance, music, theatre or other arts-related programming), including the reasons you plan to pursue a career in arts management. How do you hope to impact community through opportunities in the arts? The essay should be typed and double-spaced. It will be judged on its quality of thought, and ideas presented.

3. A resume listing your education, employment, honors and awards, and other accomplishments or affiliations that highlight your abilities, determination, and potential.

4. A copy of your most recent **OSU Advising Report**. In addition, if you have transferred to OSU from another university, please include a copy of the transcript from that institution and all other colleges and universities that you have attended.

Deadline:

You should submit the application form, the essay, your resume, and transcript no later than Tuesday, November 12, 2024. Awards will be announced in late November.
